
## FACT FILE


- Madagascar is the **4th largest island** on earth and is found off the east coast of Africa.
- 89% of its plant life, 95% of its reptiles and 92% of its mammals are **found nowhere else on earth**.
- People travel from all over the world to see its unique biodiversity, including Malagasy giant chameleons, Leaf tailed geckos, Giraffe-necked weevils and more than 110 lemur species.
- This includes Indri, Madame Berthe's Mouse Lemur, Sifaka and Ring-Tailed Lemurs.

# **!** THREATS

- Lemurs are the most endangered group of animals in the world. 95% of species are Critically Endangered, Endangered or Vulnerable.
- Over the last 50 years, nearly 1/2 of natural forest cover where lemurs live has been lost due to:
- → Logging
- → Slash & Burn Agriculture
- → Animal Grazing
- → Fires

"In one word, we try to find solutions for both wildlife and humans"





Lemurs are considered the world's oldest primates, with roots tracing back over 70 million years!



#### **FUN FACT!**

The Sifaka Lemur is often known as the dancing lemur. They mostly live in trees, but when they move across open ground, they move around with a sideways gallop with their arms up for balance - it looks like they are doing a dance!
