FACT FILE

- African lions are found south of the Sahara desert and live in a range of habitats including savannah and grasslands.
- Whilst the Asiatic lion exists in one small population around Gir Forest National Park in western India.
- Lions usually live in groups of around 10 15 animals called **prides**.
 - There are estimated to be 20,000 lions across Africa and less than 2,500 in Kenya.
 - Lions are carnivores and top predators in their environment, eating up to 40kg of meat in one meal!

▲ THREATS

The number of African lions in the wild has declined by 43% in the last 20 years and they now occupy only 8% of their historical range in Africa.

The drop in lion numbers is mostly due to habitat loss, severe drought due to climate change and conflict with humans, typically when lions kill the livestock owned by the communities, such as donkeys, cows and camels.

"My vision for the future is to see communities lead conservation efforts (...) we might even be in a world where there's no word like conservation because it's just it's just what everyone does on a daily basis."

CONSERVATION

- **Dr Shivani Bhalla** has lived and worked with her team in Samburu County, Northern Kenya for over 20 years.
- Ewaso Lions, founded in 2007, is a 100% Kenyan organisation focusing on community-led solutions to help lions and Samburu communities continue to

coexist.

Wirthlesights Mening

→ The 'Mama Simba' programme, designed by and for women, empowers them through conservation, education and actions such as digging water holes and recovering lion habitats.

→ The 'Lions Kids Camp' programme helps reframe how local children see their country's wildlife.


→ The 'Warrior Watch' network helps prevent humanlion conflict, with Samburu warriors monitoring lion populations and promoting carnivore coexistence.




